Program of study objectives: Automotive detailing technicians perform a variety of cleaning and restoration tasks on a vehicle, both inside and out, in order to restore it to its original condition or improve its appearance. This may entail thoroughly inspecting a vehicle, maintaining certain components, maintaining and dressing accessories, maintaining the engine bay and trunk, installing anti-theft devices, cleaning the interior and exterior of a vehicle, removing stains and dyeing fabric and leather, applying preventive protectants, sealing and polishing dashboards, waxing and polishing surfaces, touching up paint by hand, applying rustproofing treatments, etc.

Conditions of admission:

A person who meets the following conditions is eligible for admission to a program of study leading to an STC:

- 1 Has obtained at least Secondary III credits or the equivalent in the language of instruction, second language and mathematics;
 - or Has obtained an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary Studies (AESS);
 - or Has successfully completed the General Development Test (GDT) with or without specific prerequisites.
- 2 Has interrupted their full-time studies for at least 12 months;
 - or Is 18 years old when entering training;
 - or Has obtained a Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) or their equivalent;
 - or Meets the eligibility conditions of Emploi-Québec's workforce training measure.
