Program of study objectives: The *Bicycle Mechanics* program of study prepares students for the duties of a bicycle mechanic. Bicycle mechanics mainly see to the assembly and to the maintenance, trouble diagnosis and repair of bicycles. These tasks often require to find technical information and to order compatible bicycle parts. Frequent interaction with the clientele also requires good communication skills.

Conditions of admission:

A person who meets the following conditions is eligible for admission to a program of study leading to an STC:

- 1 Has obtained at least Secondary III credits or the equivalent in the language of instruction, second language and
- or Has obtained an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary Studies (AESS);
- or Has successfully completed the General Development Test (GDT) with or without specific prerequisites.
- 2 Has interrupted their full-time studies for at least 12 months;
- or Is 18 years old when entering training;
- Has obtained a Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) or their equivalent; or
- **or** Meets the eligibility conditions of Emploi-Québec's workforce training measure.
- This program is accessible via the <u>TCST-STC bridge</u>.
