Program of study objectives: The activities of private security guards involve protecting persons, property, establishments, premises and information mainly to prevent crime and maintain order. To accomplish this, they carry out preventive, surveillance, access control and traffic control duties. They ensure that laws, regulations and directives are complied with and intervene in emergencies. Private security guards work in industrial, commercial and residential establishments, institutions (hospitals, schools, etc.), for organizations, on sites, etc. They work for private security agencies or are employed directly by businesses, institutions or organizations in the private, public or parapublic sectors.

Conditions of admission:

A person who meets the following conditions is eligible for admission to a program of study leading to an STC:

- 1 Has obtained at least Secondary III credits or the equivalent in the language of instruction, second language and mathematics;
- or Has obtained an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary Studies (AESS);
- or Has successfully completed the General Development Test (GDT) with or without specific prerequisites.
- Has interrupted their full-time studies for at least 12 months;
- or Is 18 years old when entering training;
- or Has obtained a Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) or their equivalent;
- **or** Meets the eligibility conditions of Emploi-Québec's workforce training measure.
- This program is accessible via the TCST-STC bridge.
